There is no tax levy impact associated with the approval of this request. The premiums of \$3,159,041 will be charged to Agency 117 in the Object Lines 8055-8075 budgeted for the property and casualty program. The 2020 requested budget of objects 8055-8075 is \$4,865,957, leaving a balance of \$1,675,000 to fund the self-insured retentions and deductibles associated with these lines of coverage. The Fiduciary premiums in the amount of \$340,624 are sufficiently budgeted in the Employee Retirement Services Division of the Department of Human Resources.


- D. Describe any assumptions or interpretations that were utilized to provide the information on this form.

Adoption of this resolution will not require an expenditure of funds as they are appropriated in the 2020 Budget for Risk Management and the Department of Human Resources.

The total cost of the renewal will be \$3,499,665 for the property and casualty insurance program covering January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020.
