A professional service agreement with Sigma Group, Architects and Engineers to provide professional services for the 2018 Capital Project WO535 War Memorial Center North Lot and Greenprint plan was executed. A fee increase is being requested that would result in a total contract amount of \$178,021.61. The funding would be taken from the current project account.
- C. There are sufficient funds in the current WO535 capital budget to award the requested Fee Increase for professional services agreement to Sigma Group, Inc for the Construction Documents, bidding of the plans and Construction oversight.
