3 From the Executive Zoo Director requesting approval to create 1.0 FTE Associate
4 Veterinarian position, by recommending adoption of the following:

6 **A REVISED RESOLUTION**
7

8 WHEREAS, the Director, Milwaukee County Zoo (the Zoo), is requesting to
9 create one Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Associate Veterinarian position; and
10

11 WHEREAS, the new position will provide needed veterinary coverage to allow
12 veterinary staff a better work-life balance, to advance the Zoo's involvement in research
13 and conservation medicine, and to grant employees the ability to use their accrued
14 holiday time as off time; and
15

16 WHEREAS, the 2023 Adopted Budget includes one Senior Staff Veterinarian
17 position, and one FTE Associate Veterinarian position, who lead the veterinary team,
18 providing care for over 2,000 specimens; and
19

20 WHEREAS, Zoo animals require care 365 days per year, often after regular
21 business hours; and
22

23 WHEREAS, Zoo veterinarians regularly must work weekends and Milwaukee
24 County holidays, and when one Veterinarian is on leave or vacation, care for the Zoo's
25 animal population is entirely dependent on the other veterinarian, and there is no
26 opportunity for a Temporary Assignment to a Higher Classification, or to promote a non-
27 veterinarian to provide this care; and

29 WHEREAS, with only two FTE Veterinarian positions to care for the Zoo's animal
30 population, current staffing levels do not reflect best practices in veterinary care, and
31 other peer zoos of similar size have three or more FTE veterinarians, including:
32 Maryland Zoo in Baltimore, Cincinnati Zoo, Calgary Zoo, Oregon Zoo, National Zoo,
33 Indianapolis Zoo, Zoo Atlanta, Zoo Tampa at Lowry Park, Zoo Miami, Fresno Chaffee
34 Zoo, Phoenix Zoo, Minnesota Zoo, and Brookfield Zoo; and

36 WHEREAS, veterinary medicine is constantly advancing, and with limited
37 veterinarians whose time is already at a premium, it becomes even more challenging to
38 keep up with gold standard medical practices, and provide exceptional care to the Zoo's
39 animals; and

41 WHEREAS, the Department of Human Resources has reviewed this request for
42 a new position or additional staffing to determine the appropriate classification
43 (Associate Veterinarian) and pay grade (915E), and has submitted a report included in
44 this file; and

46 WHEREAS, the Office of Strategy, Budget, and Performance has reviewed this
47 request with respect to need, appropriateness, and funding availability as required per
48 Section 59.60(10), Wisconsin State Statutes, and has submitted a report included in this
49 file; and

51 WHEREAS, the Committee on Personnel, at its meeting of March 7, 2023,
52 recommended adoption of File No. 23-291 (vote 4-0); now, therefore,

54 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board)
55 hereby approves the classification and pay recommendation for the position, as outlined
56 in the report hereto attached to this file and summarized below:
