Kosciuszko Community Center HVAC (INFORMATION)

#### Issue

A temporary chiller unit was installed at the Kosciuszko Community center, due to a catastrophic failure of the existing chiller, which has had many major repairs over the past years. The original chiller unit was installed with the building in 1982 and had a life expectancy of 15-20 years, which our maintenance staff was able to extend to 35 years. Due to the high amount of youth programming during the summer months, the Parks dept. saw it as a high priority item and procured a chiller (rental unit), transported the unit to the site, where our HVAC staff along with some of our electricians installed the temporary power and connections to the HVAC system. The chiller was rented from the Temp-air Company for a monthly cost of approximately \$6000. Security fencing was installed around the chiller for approximately \$400 per month, since the County would be held responsible for any damages or theft. Total cost for renting the chiller for the summer (Approximately 4 months June – end of September), including equipment rental is approximately \$35,000. This does not include the labor supplied by county skilled trades for the connections, maintenance, future disconnection and transport back to the rental facility.

## Background

The Kosciuszko Community Center is home to around 300 kids who attend camp during the summer months, teens/young adults who participate in basketball leagues and utilize the workout facilities, and members of the public who rent the facilities for weddings, birthday parties etc.. Currently the entire HVAC system riddled with countless problems and is in need of a complete replacement. The chiller unit that failed was repaired last year with used parts that were salvaged from another chiller that failed next to it. It was determined the failure this year was unrepairable, and without repair options the temporary chiller was required. This item is currently number one in the Parks Capital Project list for 2019.
