Approval of this report authorizes the Director of the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) to retroactively increase the purchase of service contract with First Transit, Inc. effective January 1, 2024, through December 31, 2024. First Transit served Milwaukee County's older adult residents as the Older Adult Transportation Services (OATS) specialized transportation provider. In 2024, the OATS program experienced an increase in service demand, providing 40,288 rides and an increase of 288 rides over the approved budgeted amount.
- B. Approval of this report would retroactively increase the total contract amount by \$57,700, from \$1,550,940 to \$1,608,640. The increase is warranted to support the increase in service demand costs.
- C. DHHS is able to absorb the cost of the contract increase due to a tax levy surplus in the 2024 budget. The \$57,700 will be accrued back to the 2024 budget.
- D. No assumptions or interpretations were made.
