(ITEM) A resolution by Supervisor Weishan creating a policy for informing policymakers on Milwaukee County voting on a standing joint review board as it relates to Tax Improvement Districts, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statute 66.1105(3)(g) allows a city that is creating a tax incremental district to create a standing joint review board; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statute 66.1105(4)(m) requires that one representative be chosen by any county that has power to levy taxes on the property within the tax incremental district; and

WHEREAS, the representative shall be the County Executive or his designee or the Milwaukee County Treasurer who possesses knowledge of Milwaukee County finances; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has designated the Director of County Economic Development as the County representative to any municipal joint review boards; and

WHEREAS, it would be helpful to policymakers if the County’s representative to the joint review boards provided a regular update as to the matters considered by the joint review board(s) and any votes cast on behalf of Milwaukee County; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby requires the Milwaukee County appointed representative to a municipal joint review board to provide an informational update as soon as practicable to the Committee on Economic and Community Development related to the actions taken by any municipal joint review boards, including any votes cast by the County representative.
