- A. The Director, Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), is requesting passive review of professional services contract amendments with InPower for \$100,000, from \$75,000 to \$175,000, and Health Connections Inc., for \$195,000, from \$99,999 to \$294,999.
 - B. Amending the contract agreements would provide an additional \$100,000 to Inpower and \$195,000 to Health Connections Inc. for a total increase of \$295,000. The contracts would be extended until June 30, 2025.
 - C. Amending the contract agreements increases total expenditures by \$295,000 which will be offset by revenues of \$295,000 for a net zero tax levy impact. The cost of these contracts is fully covered by a no-cost extension of the original USAging Aging and Disability Vaccination collaborative grant available through April 15, 2025, and the DHS-Bureau of Communicable Diseases (BCD) Vaccination Outreach Grant which is effective from 1/1/2024 to 6/30/2025.
 - D. No assumptions or interpretations were made during the preparation of this fiscal note.
