  - A. The Executive Zoo Director is requesting the creation of one position of Zoological Medicine and Surgery Resident to participate in the American College of Zoological Medicine (ACZM) zoological medicine residency program.
  - B. The American College of Zoological Residency (ACZM) Training Program Committee is charged with evaluating residency or graduate programs in zoological medicine to determine if they meet the appropriate standards for qualifying trainees for the ACZM board examination. ACZM approval will be required before starting this program but must be applied for in advance. To meet the timeline, the position of Zoological Medicine and Surgery Resident needs to be created in 2025 so the paperwork for the accreditation process can be completed and ready for July 2026 which would be the anticipated start date for this position. In addition, although the individual will not start until July 2026, the application process for this position through the ACZM will begin in November 2025 with the applicant being informed of their acceptance into the program in March 2026.

In 2025, there will be no cost associated with the position. The estimated cost for 2026, with a projected start date of July 20, 2026, is \$18,672. Of this amount, 50%, or \$9,336, will be reimbursed by the Zoological Society of Milwaukee. This results in a net cost of \$9,336 to the Zoo. Starting in 2027, the annual cost is estimated to be \$44,137, excluding any County-wide approved wage increases. The Zoological Society of Milwaukee will continue to cover 50% of the position's cost, while the Zoo will absorb its share within the operating budget.
