- B. The property owners are requesting the County subordinate its lien, issued in 2014, due to the refinancing of a first mortgage. An appraisal indicates there is sufficient equity in the property to protect the County's lien (total debt after refinancing of \$188,000 under a current appraised value of \$235,000). In addition, the clients have a good payment record on their County loan and property taxes are current.
