REQUEST

This report is intended to provide an update on the Milwaukee County American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) project pipeline and expenditure category allocations approved during the Milwaukee County ARPA Task Force Meeting on September 2, 2021.

POLICY

Milwaukee County Board file 21-555: "A resolution to create a Task Force to review and recommend funding allocations to the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors for monies received by the County in the Federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021"

BACKGROUND


On September 2, 2021, the ARPA Task Force approved ARPA Expenditure Categories and a process for reviewing and recommending ARPA funding allocations. Since that time ARPA funding requests have been submitted based on the Milwaukee County ARPA Expenditure Categories (Community Support, COVID-19 Mitigation, Fund Administration, and Revenue Loss Recovery). This report serves to provide updates on projects approved for ARPA funding by the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (Table A), ARPA Funding Allocated and Available as of May 5, 2022 (Diagram A), Milwaukee County ARPA Project Pipeline (Table B), and Community Feedback submitted as of May 5, 2022 (Table C). Service Area subgroups continue to meet on a regular basis. Updates on subgroup activities are provided below.

Service Area Subgroups Updates

Community Support. The Household Assistance, Mental & Behavioral Health, and Other Social Determinants of Health (SDoH) Subgroups continue to meet monthly to review projects (Appendix A). Community Support subgroups weigh project ideas against the criteria set forth by the ARPA Task Force as well as all other submitted projects to determine the best use of ARPA funds.

COVID-19 Mitigation. The COVID-19 Mitigation Subgroup continues to meet on a regular basis to review projects and evaluate the most efficient way to approve project submissions. The subgroup continues to review membership that aligns with the COVID-19 Mitigation Charter. As of May 5, 2022, the subgroup has reviewed 16 requests for COVID-19 mitigation funds and approved \$1,069,718 in expenses of the \$2,500,000 COVID-19 Mitigation allocation approved by Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors.

Fund Administration. The Fund Administration Subgroup continues to meet on a monthly basis to discuss the following topics and related funding requests: Community Support Subgroup Progress, Community Engagement, Fiscal Tracking, Program and Fund Evaluation, Treasury Reporting, and Federal, State & Local Collaboration. The subgroup is preparing to release an Evaluation Request for Proposals (RFP) to meet U.S. Department of the Treasury evaluation requirements. The Fund Administration group will request \$4,000,000 of the \$7,347,848 in Fund Administration to release the RFP and contract with an external evaluator. The Grant Accounting Services project request is pending approval by the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisor. The State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds Project and Expenditure quarterly report was submitted to the United States Department of Treasury on April 29, 2022.

Revenue Loss Recovery. The Revenue Loss Recovery Subgroup created the Fiscal Health Project Challenge to improve Milwaukee County's fiscal position through cost savings, revenue generation, and operational improvements. Through the Fiscal Health Challenge, 14 projects are recommended by the ARPA Revenue Loss Recovery Subgroup to receive a total of \$24,167,707. Four projects totaling \$3,791,240 are being recommended to the ARPA Task Force in May 2022. Ten projects totaling \$20,376,467 were previously recommended by the ARPA Task Force on March 10, 2022 and are pending Milwaukee County Board approval. The Revenue Loss Recovery subgroup will assess and recommend capital project expenses that will support the County's fiscal health.
