3 An Action Report from the Project Management Office, Office of Strategy, Budget, and
4 Performance, and the Co-Chairpersons, Milwaukee County Commission on Youth,
5 requesting confirmation of the individuals selected by the Milwaukee County Youth
6 Commission to serve in 2024, by recommending adoption of the following:

8 **A RESOLUTION**

10 WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Commission on Youth (Youth Commission)
11 was created in 2002 to serve as a representative body for youth in Milwaukee County;
12 and
13

14 WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors, at its Committee of the
15 Whole meeting on May 26, 2022, unanimously recommended adoption of File No. 22-
16 662 (vote 18-0) to re-establish the Youth Commission; and

18 WHEREAS, the re-established Youth Commission held its initial meeting on
19 January 25, 2023, and has met every consecutive month since that time; and
20

21 WHEREAS, per adopted File No. 22-662: “Once seated, the commission on
22 youth will appoint from within its ranks a selection committee of not less than five (5)
23 commissioners. The selection committee will determine when applications may be
24 submitted, conduct application reviews, interview candidates, and submit names to the
25 county board of supervisors for confirmation”; and

27 WHEREAS, the Youth Commission designated its Committee on Governance,
28 Finance, and Evaluation as the selection committee under File No. 22-662, and
29 empowered the Commission Co-Chairpersons (Co-Chairpersons) to make decisions
30 regarding the selection process between meetings; and

32 WHEREAS, the Co-Chairpersons re-assigned the scoring to the Youth
33 Commission Leadership Committee, which consists of the two Co-Chairpersons, and
34 the Chairpersons and Vice Chairpersons of both standing committees, for the 2024
35 applicants; and

37 WHEREAS, because the Youth Commissioners serve staggered terms,
38 approximately nine seats are open each year (subject to the ages of the selected
39 candidates remaining 14-18 during their respective terms); and
40

41 WHEREAS, the selected candidates (top ranked applicant in each open district)
42 appeared before the Committee on Governance, Finance, and Evaluation on
43 November 1, 2023, and November 15, 2023, and received unanimous approval; and

45 WHEREAS, the Youth Commission has approved the selection of the following
46 candidates to represent the districts indicated herein for the term lengths noted; and

- Daniel Damon to represent the 10th District for a term of January 2, 2024, to January 1, 2025
- D'Mario Cockfield to represent the 13th District for a term of January 2, 2024, to January 1, 2026.
