From the District Attorney, Office of the District Attorney, requesting assignment of an additional Milwaukee County vehicle, which is required to allow for the safe, secure, and sanitary transport of persons experiencing mental health crises under the Crisis Assessment Response Team project, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

 WHEREAS, File No. 17-320, adopted on April 20, 2017, approved funding in the courts' budget, with the consent of the Chief Judge, First Judicial District, Combined Court Related Operations, under the John D. and Catherine T. MacArthur Safety and Justice Challenge Phase II Implementation Grant (MacArthur Grant) award, for the creation of 1.0 full-time equivalent position of District Attorney Investigator; and

WHEREAS, the MacArthur Grant funding is for 18 months, with the option to extend if additional MacArthur Grant award funds are available, in the amount of \$150,000 for the District Attorney Investigator's salary and fringe benefits; and

WHEREAS, the MacArthur Grant award includes funding to enhance Crisis Assessment Response Teams (CART) for Milwaukee County (the County) residents experiencing mental health crises; and

WHEREAS, the CART District Attorney Investigator will work closely with mental and behavioral health crisis response workers to respond county-wide as a team to law enforcement incidents in which citizens are in need of emergency mental health services, and to provide direct services to citizens in need as a potential alternative to incarceration, primarily in the suburban jurisdictions of the County, which are currently underserved; and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney Investigator position requires a specially-equipped, larger model law enforcement sport utility vehicle with emergency lights, siren, and police radio, in addition to special equipment to allow for the safe, secure, and sanitary transport of persons experiencing a mental health crisis; and no such specially-equipped vehicle exists in the current district attorney fleet; and

WHEREAS, the Fleet Management Division, Department of Transportation (DOT), estimates the costs of the CART vehicle and special equipment, including vehicle maintenance, fuel, and debt service, to be \$57,000, amortized over seven years at an annual cost of approximately \$8,143; and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney's Office will absorb the 2017 costs of the CART vehicle in its adopted budget and will ask the Fleet Management Division, DOT, to include the 2018 charges for the vehicle in the Recommended Budget; and
