From the Executive Zoo Director requesting authorization to enter into a contract for seasonal “birds of prey” presentations for the Zoo in partnership with World Bird Sanctuary in 2022, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Zoo (the Zoo) is one of the top four attractions and largest cultural institution in Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the Zoo grounds lie on a 192-acre wooded campus, and is home to 2,200 specimens of 330 species; and

WHEREAS, Section 59.52(31)(c), Wisconsin State Statutes, requires the approval of the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors for any single contract or group of contracts between the same parties, with a value or aggregate value of more than \$300,000; and

WHEREAS, the Zoo sent out Requests for Proposals (RFP) for the development, production, management, and execution of a seasonal Birds of Prey show; and

WHEREAS, proposals were received and reviewed by a review committee per Milwaukee County procurement rules; and

WHEREAS, the World Bird Sanctuary (the Vendor) submitted a proposal that met all the terms and conditions of the RFP, and received the highest score from the review committee; and

WHEREAS, the term of the 2022 Birds of Prey Presentation Contract (the Contract) would extend from February 1, 2022, until December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Vendor would schedule three presentations per day, seven days per week, from May 30, 2022, through September 5, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Zoo agrees to pay the Vendor the sum of \$110,760 in six equal installments throughout the term of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Zoo’s 2022 Adopted Budget includes funding for this contract; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of January 27, 2022, recommended adoption of File No. 21-1125 (vote 7-0); now, therefore,

45 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby
46 authorizes the Executive Zoo Director, Milwaukee County Zoo (the Zoo), to enter into an
47 agreement for the development, production, management, and execution of seasonal
48 Birds of Prey presentations for the Zoo at Northwestern Mutual Family Farm with World
49 Bird Sanctuary.
