1 By Supervisors O'Connor, Eckblad, Capriolo, File No. 25-315 2 Martin, Vincent, Rolland, Shea, Gómez-Tom, Bielinski, 3 Logsdon, and Coggs-Jones 4 5 AN ENGROSSED RESOLUTION 6 7 to support the Milwaukee County Sustainable Design Standards in alignment with the 8 County's goal to be carbon neutral by 2050 9 10 WHEREAS, on Earth Day 2021, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors 11 adopted File No. 21-389 committing the County to achieve carbon neutral operations by 12 2050; and 13 14 WHEREAS, Milwaukee County has been working towards this goal in a variety of 15 ways, achieving a 46% reduction in emissions in 2023 since the base year of 2005; and 16 17 WHEREAS, Milwaukee County has adopted a comprehensive Climate Action 18 2050 Plan (CA50) that establishes a clear roadmap toward achieving carbon neutrality 19 in County operations by 2050 and advancing resilience through climate adaptation 20 strategies; and 21 22 WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Office of Sustainability has developed, with 23 the collaboration of many county stakeholders, the Sustainable Design Standards, 24 hereto attached to this file, as a tool to operationalize the CA50 Plan by incorporating 25 equity-focused, energy-efficient, and climate-resilient practices into the planning, 26 design, and construction of County-owned facilities; and 27 28 WHEREAS, approximately 65% of Milwaukee County's operational emissions 29 are associated with its building portfolio, making the Sustainable Design Standards a 30 primary climate action strategy to achieve carbon neutrality; and 31 32 WHEREAS, the Sustainable Design Standards are a set of standards on 33 sustainability measures like renewable energy, water conservation, and occupant health 34 and well-being to be implemented during the design and construction processes; and 35 36 WHEREAS, the Sustainable Design Standards will enable greater resource 37 efficiency in the long-term by ensuring that County resources are allocated in alignment

with all relevant goals; and

40 WHEREAS, the level of requirements is divided into two Tiers, to be determined 41 for each project based on the cost and scope, as detailed in the Sustainable Design 42 Standards; and 43 44 WHEREAS, to prevent any undue burden that may affect the completion and 45 viability of certain projects, certain exemptions have been outlined in the Sustainable 46 Design Standards as well as an exemption process that can be pursued during the Pre-47 Design stage; and 48 49 WHEREAS, it has been shown that adhering to sustainability standards can 50 result in significant cost savings, such as the current upgrades of LED fixtures that will 51 result in an estimated 30% reduction in energy costs for Milwaukee County; and, 52 53 WHEREAS, the Sustainable Design Standards institutionalizes Milwaukee 54 County's commitment to environmental stewardship, equity, and resilience by promoting 55 strategies such as energy efficiency, emissions reduction, and adaptive infrastructure; 56 and 57 58 WHEREAS, the Committee on Community, Environment, and Economic 59 60 File No. 25-315 (vote 5-0); now, therefore, 61 62 63 64

Development, at its meeting of May 12, 2025, recommended adoption of

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors supports the Office of Sustainability's Sustainable Design Standards, as hereto attached to this file, by incorporating equity-focused, energy-efficient, and climate-resilient practices into the planning, design, and construction of County-owned facilities; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors strongly encourages the inclusion of the Office of Sustainability's Sustainable Design Standards for consideration in all relevant construction project requests for bids and proposals; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors supports all relevant projects meeting applicable minimum mandatory requirements as detailed in the Sustainable Design Standards attached to this file-; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all projects using the Sustainable Design Standards in any way shall include the anticipated long and short term budget impacts from utilizing the Sustainable Design Standards in all communications, reports, and presentations for that given project.
