Previous Committee Action

- ➤ IRC established Redistricting Criteria for Commission to use at August 27th Meeting.
 - 1. "Honoring the intent of the Voting Rights Act, and recognition of ethnic and racial communities of interest, while noting that race is a social construct." Protecting the ability of racial and language minority groups to participate equally in the electoral process by drawing of District boundaries that comply with the Voting Rights Act of 1965.
 - 2. "Respect for municipal boundaries" To the extent possible, Districts will consist of whole contiguous municipalities or contiguous parts of the same municipality within the same District.
 - 3. "Equalization of population between districts, and that SEWRPC shall aspire and endeavor to make the deviation as small as possible, with the deviation for each district at no more than (+) / (-) 4 percent." Each District be divided equally in population, with a deviation rate of +/- 4 percent to be used as a target to define what is meant to be equal.
 - 4. "Compactness of Districts." Each District will be designed to be in a compact form as possible












Potential Districts - Version A

 - Compactness





 - Equal Population














Version B - Summary

- ➤ Compactness slightly less












Potential Districts - Version C

 - Compactness




