Successfully Move Court Operations to Children's Court during the RNC in July 2024

- 102 Staff Members within Criminal, Civil, IT Services, and Milwaukee Justice Center moved to Children's Court for the week the RNC was in Milwaukee.
- Collaborative efforts between County IT Services, Phone Services, and Facilities.









Goal 3

Address Space and Environmental Concerns with Evidence Rooms

- Clerk of Circuit Courts is responsible to maintain evidence in criminal cases for as long as <u>50 years past the last possible</u> <u>date of appeal.</u>
- Currently, the evidence is in 4 rooms on 3 different floors of the Safety Building.
 Leaking ceilings, temperature issues, and extremely limited secure space are significant factors.
- ARPA Funds secured to renovate Room 307 in the Courthouse to house evidence and the Criminal Division Team.
