14 15 16 17 18	WHEREAS, Capital Project WT079 -Milwaukee County Transit System (MCTS) Fleet Maintenance Roof Replacement (Capital Project WT079), was approved for design and construction in the Milwaukee County 2019-20 Capital Budgets, to replace the over 30-year old roof at a cost over \$3.75M; and
<ol> <li>19</li> <li>20</li> <li>21</li> <li>22</li> <li>23</li> <li>24</li> </ol>	WHEREAS, damage occurred to the fire protection and electrical systems at the MCTS Hillside Fleet Maintenance facility while the roofing contractor was performing the roof replacement, shorting out the electrical system, and damaging the fire protection system beyond repair; and
25 26 27 28	WHEREAS, Kelmann Restoration teamed with Grunau Company to address the fire protection system, and Pro Electric, Inc., for the electrical system, was brought in under an Emergency Restoration Contract to attend to restoring the power and fire protection system; and

42 43 44	WHEREAS, the cost of the emergency repair/replacement of the electrical, electrical capacitor banks, and fire protection systems is \$521,000; and
45 46 47	WHEREAS, these costs, along with the cost of the fire watch, will be reviewed for inclusion in the claim against the roofing contractor's insurance company; and

48 WHEREAS, the accepted bid for Capital Project WT079, which is approximately 49 85 percent complete, was significantly lower than the construction budget amount of 50 \$3,754,536; and 51 52 WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds in existing Capital Project WT079 to cover 53 the costs for the electrical repair, electrical capacitor banks, and fire protection 54 restoration, and still have an estimated surplus for the project in the amount of \$1.17 55 million; and 56 57 58 WHEREAS, all of the \$3,754,536 in financing for construction was budgeted to be provided from general obligation bonds; and 59 60 61 WHEREAS, some of the items in the revised scope of work are not eligible for bond financing, therefore, the appropriation transfer request includes cash financing in 62 the amount of \$521,663 from the Appropriation for Contingency, and correspondingly 63 reduces the project bonding authority in a like amount; and 64 65 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of July 26, 2021, 66 67 recommended adoption of File No. 21-608 (vote 7-0); now, therefore, 68 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) 69 hereby authorizes and directs the Office of Performance, Strategy and Budget (OPSB), 70 Department of Administrative Services (DAS), and the Office of the Comptroller 71 (Comptroller) to provide an appropriation transfer to modify the scope of Capital Project 72 WT079 – Milwaukee County Transit System Fleet Maintenance Roof Replacement 73 (Capital Project WT079) to include the scope of work for replacement of the fire 74 protection system, repair/replace various electrical conduits and wiring, and provide a 75 new electrical capacitor bank; and 76 77 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board hereby authorizes and directs 78 the OPSB-DAS, and the Comptroller to include in the appropriation transfer use of the 79 80 Appropriation for Contingency of \$521,663 to finance items that are ineligible for bond financing and reduce bonding authority by the same amount; and 81 82 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board hereby authorizes and directs 83 the OPSB-DAS, and the Comptroller to reduce bond financing authority by \$1,100,000 84 to realign the project budget due to the lower than expected bid amount for construction. 85 86 87 88 srb 89 07/26/2021

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
