PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT

VETERINARY SERVICES

This contract between Milwaukee County, a Wisconsin municipal body corporate represented by the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office, 821 W. State Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, 53233 (hereinafter called County) and Brentwood Animal Hospital, 318 W. Ryan Road, Oak Creek, WI 53154 (hereinafter called Contractor) is entered into on January 1, 2017.

1. Scope of Services

This contract will provide veterinary services for security dogs of the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office based at the Milwaukee County Jail, Patrol or Airport Security.

Contractor shall specifically perform all of the tasks and achieve the objectives set forth below:

Contractor must be able to handle twenty dogs.

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2. Dates of Performance

This contract is for a period of thirty-six months, January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2019 and renewable, separately, for up to two additional calendar 12 month periods. This contract will automatically renew unless the County notifies the Contractor of intent not to renew the contract 90 days prior to the December 31st expiration.

3. Compensation

Contractor shall not charge in excess of \$24,999 per annual term without the approval of the K-9 Unit Commander. Services will be provided at a 5% discount and then a 10% discount from usual and customary rates, with the exception of no discount for laboratory tests sent to outside laboratories and for prescription diets. Billings shall be monthly. State Prompt Pay Law, Section 66.285, does not apply to this contract. As a matter of practice, the County attempts to pay all invoices in 30 days. If no disputes arise, and the invoice has not been paid 60 days after it was received by the County, the Contractor may file a claim for 1.5% (annual rate) on amounts not paid after the 60th day.

4. Indemnity

The Contractor agrees to the fullest extent permitted by law, to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the County and its agents, officers and employees, from and against all loss or expense including costs and attorney's fees by reason of liability for damages including suits at law or in equity, caused by any wrongful, intentional, or negligent act or omission of the Contractor, or its (their) agents which may arise out of or are connected with the activities covered by this contract. Contractor shall indemnify and save County harmless from any award of damages and costs against County for any action based on U.S. Patent or Copyright infringement regarding computer programs involved in the performance of the tasks and services covered by this contract. Contractor also shall indemnify and hold County harmless for any and all transportation of dogs in Contractor vehicles.

5. Insurance

Contractor understands and agrees that financial responsibility for claims or damages to any person, or to Contractor's employees and agents, shall rest with the Contractor. Contractor may effect and maintain any insurance coverage, including, but not limited to, Worker's Compensation, Employers Liability and General, Contractual, Professional and Automobile Liability, to support such financial obligations. The indemnification obligation, however, shall not be reduced in any way by existence or non-existence, limitation, amount or type of damages, compensation or benefits payable under Worker's Compensation laws or other insurance provisions.

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Evidence of Worker's Compensation (with a waiver of subrogation in favor of Milwaukee County by policy endorsement) and General Liability and Automobile Liability insurance shall be given the County by a certificate naming the County as an additional insured on general and automobile coverages and affording a thirty (30) day written notice of cancellation, non-renewal, or known material change for the duration of this Contract. Certificate of Insurance showing all coverages, with Milwaukee County and the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office named as additional insured parties must be provided before contract commencement.

Contractor agrees to provide a statement declaring that it does not carry commercial auto liability insurance and assumes all automobile related risk whether personal or commercial should Contractor transport any County/MCSO dogs.

The Contractor shall purchase and maintain policies of insurance and proof of financial responsibility to cover costs as may arise from claims of tort, statutes, and benefits under Workers' Compensation laws, as respects damage to persons or property and third parties in such coverages and amounts as required and approved by the County Director of Risk Management and Insurance. Acceptable proof of such coverages shall be furnished to the Director of Risk Management and Insurance prior to services commencing under this agreement.

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MILWAUKEE COUNTY, AS ITS INTEREST MAY APPEAR, SHALL BE NAMED AS AN ADDITIONAL INSURED FOR GENERAL, AUTOMOBILE, GARAGE KEEPERS LEGAL AND ENVIRONMENTAL IMPAIRMENT LIABILITY, AS RESPECTS THE SERVICES PROVIDED IN THIS AGREEMENT. DISCLOSURE MUST BE MADE OF ANY NON STANDARD OR RESTRICTIVE ADDITIONAL INSURED ENDORSEMENT, AND ANY USE OF NON STANDARD OR RESTRICTIVE ADDITIONAL INSURED ENDORSEMENT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTABLE, A THIRTY (30) DAY WRITTEN NOTICE OF CANCELLATION, NON-RENEWAL, OR MATERIAL CHANGE SHALL BE AFFORDED TO THE COUNTY.

The insurance specified above shall be placed with an "A" rated carrier per Best's Rating Guide approved to do business in the State of Wisconsin. Any deviations or waiver of required coverages or minimums shall be submitted in writing and approved by the County Director of Risk Management and Insurance as a condition of this agreement. Waivers may be granted when surplus lines and specialty carriers are used.

A Certificate of Insurance shall be submitted for review to the COUNTY for each successive period of coverage for the duration of this agreement.

A.1. Compliance with Governmental Requirements

The Contractor shall evidence satisfactory compliance for Unemployment Compensation and Social Security reporting as required by Federal and State laws.

A.2. Professional Liability - Additional Provisions

The Contractor agrees to provide additional information on their professional liability coverages as respects policy type, i.e., errors & omissions for consultants, architects, and/or engineers, etc.; applicable retention levels; coverage form, i.e., claims-made, occurrence; discovery clause conditions, and effective retroactive and expiration dates, to the County Director of Risk Management and Insurance as may be requested to obtain approval of coverages as respects this section.

It is understood and agreed that coverages which apply to the services inherent in this agreement will be extended for two (2) years after completion of all work contemplated in this project if coverage is written on a claims-made basis.

The Contractor shall certify and make available loss information from any Insurer as to any claims filed or pending against any and all professional liability coverages in effect for the past five (5) years, if requested. The Contractor shall certify to inform the Owner of any claims filed for errors and omissions that may be covered under professional coverages pursuant to the work within ten (10) days of notice of the occurrence or claim filing, whichever is sooner.

Deviations and waivers may be requested in writing based on market conditions to the County Director of Risk Management and Insurance. Approval shall be given in writing of any acceptable

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deviation or waiver to the Contractor prior to the Contractor effecting any change in conditions as contained in this section. Waivers shall not be unduly withheld nor denied without consultation with the Contractor.

It is understood and agreed that the Contractor will obtain information on the professional liability coverages of all sub-contractors and/or sub-consultants in the same form as specified above for review of the Owner.

6. Contract Termination

This contract may be terminated thirty (30) days following written notice by County or Contractor for any reason unless an earlier date is determined by County to be essential to the safety and well being of the dogs and handlers covered by this contract. Failure to comply with any part of this contract may be considered cause for early termination. The County will only be liable for services rendered through the date of termination and not for the uncompleted portion, or any materials or services purchased or paid by Contractor for use in completing this contract.

Contractor shall notify County, in writing, whenever it is unable to provide the required quality or quantity of services. Upon such notification, County and Contractor shall determine whether such inability will require a revision or early termination of this contract.

7. Contract Renegotiation

This contract may be renegotiated in the event of changes required by law, regulations, court action, or inability of either party to perform as committed in this contract.

8. Independent Contractor

Nothing contained in this contract shall constitute or be construed to create a partnership or joint venture between County and Contractor or its successors or assignees. In entering into this contract and in action in compliance herewith, Contractor is at all times acting and performing as an independent contractor, duly authorized to perform the acts required of it hereunder.

9. Subcontracts

Assignment of any portion of the work by subcontract must have the prior written approval of County.

10. Assignment Limitation

This Agreement shall be binding upon and insure to the benefit of the parties and their successors and assigns; provided, however, that neither party shall assign its obligations hereunder without the prior written consent of the other.

11. Prohibited Practices

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- A. Contractor during the period of this contract shall not retain or utilize for compensation any member, officer or employee of County or any person who to the knowledge of Contractor has a conflict of interest.
- B. Contractor hereby attests that it is familiar with Milwaukee County's Code of Ethics, which states in part, "No person may offer to give to any County officer or employee or his immediate family, and no County officer or his immediate family may solicit or receive anything of value pursuant to an understanding that such officer or employee vote, official actions or judgment would be influenced thereby."

12. Non-discrimination, Equal Employment Opportunity and Affirmative Action Programs

In the performance of work under this Contract, Contractor shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, color, national origin, age, sex or handicap, which shall include but not be limited to the following:

Employment upgrading, demotion or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training including apprenticeships. Contractor will post in conspicuous places, available for employees and applicants for employment, notices to be provided by County, setting forth the provisions of the non-discrimination clause.

Contractor agrees that it will strive to implement the principle of equal employment opportunities through an effective affirmative action program, and has so indicated in the certificate which is attached hereto as Appendix A and made a part of this Contract. The program shall have as its objective to increase the utilization of women, minorities and handicapped persons, and other protected groups, at all levels of employment in all divisions of Contractor's work force where these groups may have been previously under-utilized and under-represented. Contractor also agrees that in the event of any dispute as to compliance with the forestalled requirements, it shall be its responsibility to show that it has met all such requirements.

When a violation of the non-discrimination, equal opportunity or affirmative action provisions of this section has been determined by County, Contractor shall immediately be informed of the violation and directed to take all action necessary to halt the violation, as well as such action as may be necessary to correct, if possible, any injustice to any person adversely affected by the violation, and immediately take steps to prevent further violations.

If, after notice of a violation to Contractor, further violations of this section are committed during the term of the Contract, County may terminate the Contract without liability for the uncompleted portion of any materials or services purchased or paid for by Contractor for use in completing the Contract, or it may permit Contractor to complete the Contract, but in either event, Contractor shall be ineligible to bid on any further Contract let by County.

13. Audit and Inspection of Records

Contractor shall permit the authorized representatives of County, after reasonable notice, to inspect and audit all data and records of contractor related to carrying out this Contract for a period up to three years after completion of the Contract. The prime consultant must obtain prior written Milwaukee County approval for all subconsultants and/or associates to be used in performing its contractual obligations. There must be a written contractual agreement between the prime consultant and its County approved subconsultant and/or associates which binds the subconsultant to the same audit contract terms and conditions as the prime consultant.

14. Notices


Notices to County provided in this contract shall be sufficient if sent by certified or registered mail, postage prepaid, addressed to Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office, Richard Schmidt, Inspector, 821 W. State St. Suite 107, Milwaukee, WI 53233 and notice to Contractor shall be sufficient if sent by certified or registered mail, postage prepaid to Laura Konopski, Practice Manager, Brentwood Animal Hospital, 318 W. Ryan Road, Oak Creek, WI 53154, or to such other respective addresses as the parties may designate to each other, in writing, from time to time.
