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Report on Internal Control Over Financial Reporting and on Compliance and Other Matters Based on an Audit of Financial Statements Performed in Accordance With Government Auditing Standards

Independent Auditors' Report

To the Board of Supervisors of County of Milwaukee

We have audited, in accordance with the auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America and the standards applicable to financial audits contained in Government Auditing Standards issued by the Comptroller General of the United States (Government Auditing Standards), the financial statements of the governmental activities, the business-type activities, the aggregate discretely presented component units, each major fund, and the aggregate remaining fund information of County of Milwaukee (the County) as of and for the year ended December 31, 2024, and the related notes to the financial statements, which collectively comprise the County's basic financial statements, and have issued our report thereon dated July 31, 2025. Our report includes a reference to other auditors who audited the financial statements of the Milwaukee County War Memorial, Inc. and the Marcus Center of the Performing Arts, as described in our report on the County's financial statements. The financial statements of the Milwaukee Public Museum, Inc., the Milwaukee County War Memorial, Inc. and the Marcus Center of the Performing Arts were not audited in accordance with Government Auditing Standards, and accordingly, this report does not include reporting on internal control over financial reporting or compliance and other matters associated with the Milwaukee Public Museum, Inc., the Milwaukee County War Memorial, Inc. and the Marcus Center of the Performing Arts. Our report also includes a reference to other auditors who audited the financial statements of the Employees' Retirement System of the County of Milwaukee, as described in our report on the County's financial statements. This report does not include the results of the other auditors' testing of internal control over financial reporting or compliance and other matters that are reported on separately by those auditors.

Report on Internal Control Over Financial Reporting

In planning and performing our audit of the financial statements, we considered the County's internal control over financial reporting (internal control) as a basis for designing audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances for the purpose of expressing our opinions on the financial statements, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the County's internal control. Accordingly, we do not express an opinion on the effectiveness of the County's internal control.

A deficiency in internal control exists when the design or operation of a control does not allow management or employees, in the normal course of performing their assigned functions, to prevent, or detect and correct, misstatements on a timely basis. A material weakness is a deficiency, or a combination of deficiencies, in internal control, such that there is a reasonable possibility that a material misstatement of the entity's financial statements will not be prevented, or detected and corrected, on a timely basis. A significant deficiency is a deficiency, or a combination of deficiencies, in internal control that is less severe than a material weakness, yet important enough to merit attention by those charged with governance.

Our consideration of internal control was for the limited purpose described in the first paragraph of this section and was not designed to identify all deficiencies in internal control that might be material weaknesses or significant deficiencies. Given these limitations, during our audit we did not identify any deficiencies in internal control that we consider to be material weaknesses. However, material weaknesses or significant deficiencies may exist that were not identified.

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Report on Compliance and Other Matters

As part of obtaining reasonable assurance about whether the County's financial statements are free from material misstatement, we performed tests of its compliance with certain provisions of laws, regulations, contracts, and grant agreements, noncompliance with which could have a direct and material effect on the financial statements. However, providing an opinion on compliance with those provisions was not an objective of our audit, and accordingly, we do not express such an opinion. The results of our tests disclosed no instances of noncompliance or other matters that are required to be reported under *Government Auditing Standards*.

Purpose of This Report

The purpose of this report is solely to describe the scope of our testing of internal control and compliance and the results of that testing, and not to provide an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control or on compliance. This report is an integral part of an audit performed in accordance with *Government Auditing Standards* in considering the entity's internal control and compliance. Accordingly, this communication is not suitable for any other purpose.

Independent Auditors' Report

To the Board of Supervisors of County of Milwaukee

Report on Compliance for Each Major Federal and Major State Program

Opinion on Each Major Federal and Major State Program

We have audited the County of Milwaukee's (the County) compliance with the types of compliance requirements identified as subject to audit in the OMB *Compliance Supplement* and the *State Single Audit Guidelines* (the *Guidelines*) that could have a direct and material effect on each of the County's major federal and major state programs for the year ended December 31, 2024. The County's major federal and major state programs are identified in the summary of auditors' results section of the accompanying schedule of findings and questioned costs.

In our opinion, the County complied, in all material respects, with the compliance requirements referred to above that could have a direct and material effect on each of its major federal and major state programs for the year ended December 31, 2024.

Basis for Opinion on Each Major Federal and Major State Program

We conducted our audit of compliance in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAS); the standards applicable to financial audits contained in *Government Auditing Standards* issued by the Comptroller General of the United States (*Government Auditing Standards*); the audit requirements of Title 2 U.S. *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 200, *Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards* (Uniform Guidance); and the *Guidelines*. Our responsibilities under those standards, the Uniform Guidance, and the *Guidelines* are further described in the Auditors' Responsibilities for the Audit of Compliance section of our report.

We are required to be independent of the County and to meet our other ethical responsibilities, in accordance with relevant ethical requirements relating to our audit. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion on compliance for each major federal and major state program. Our audit does not provide a legal determination of the County's compliance with the compliance requirements referred to above.

Responsibilities of Management for Compliance

Management is responsible for compliance with the requirements referred to above and for the design, implementation, and maintenance of effective internal control over compliance with the requirements of laws, statutes, regulations, rules and provisions of contracts or grant agreements applicable to the County's federal and state programs.

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Auditors' Responsibilities for the Audit of Compliance

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether material noncompliance with the compliance requirements referred to above occurred, whether due to fraud or error, and express an opinion on the County's compliance based on our audit. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not absolute assurance and therefore is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with GAAS, Government Auditing Standards, the Uniform Guidance, and the Guidelines will always detect material noncompliance when it exists. The risk of not detecting material noncompliance resulting from fraud is higher than for that resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control. Noncompliance with the compliance requirements referred to above is considered material, if there is a substantial likelihood that, individually or in the aggregate, it would influence the judgment made by a reasonable user of the report on compliance about the County's compliance with the requirements of each major federal and major state program as a whole.

In performing an audit in accordance with GAAS, *Government Auditing Standards*, the Uniform Guidance, and the *Guidelines*, we:

- Exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit.
- Identify and assess the risks of material noncompliance, whether due to fraud or error, and design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks. Such procedures include examining, on a test basis, evidence regarding the County's compliance with the compliance requirements referred to above and performing such other procedures as we considered necessary in the circumstances.
- Obtain an understanding of the County's internal control over compliance relevant to the audit in order
 to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances and to test and report on internal
 control over compliance in accordance with the Uniform Guidance and the *Guidelines*, but not for the
 purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the County's internal control over
 compliance. Accordingly, no such opinion is expressed.

We are required to communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and any significant deficiencies and material weaknesses in internal control over compliance that we identified during the audit.

Report on Internal Control Over Compliance

Our consideration of internal control over compliance was for the limited purpose described in the Auditors' Responsibilities for the Audit of Compliance section above and was not designed to identify all deficiencies in internal control over compliance that might be material weaknesses or significant deficiencies in internal control over compliance and therefore, material weaknesses or significant deficiencies may exist that were not identified. We did not identify any deficiencies in internal control over compliance that we consider to be material weaknesses. However, as discussed below, we did identify certain deficiencies in internal control that we consider to be significant deficiencies.

A deficiency in internal control over compliance exists when the design or operation of a control over compliance does not allow management or employees, in the normal course of performing their assigned functions, to prevent, or detect and correct, noncompliance with a type of compliance requirement of a federal or state program on a timely basis. A material weakness in internal control over compliance is a deficiency, or a combination of deficiencies, in internal control over compliance, such that there is a reasonable possibility that material noncompliance with a type of compliance requirement of a federal or state program will not be prevented, or detected and corrected, on a timely basis. A significant deficiency in internal control over compliance is a deficiency, or a combination of deficiencies, in internal control over compliance with a type of compliance requirement of a federal or state program that is less severe than a material weakness in internal control over compliance, yet important enough to merit attention by those charged with governance. We consider the deficiencies in internal control over compliance described in the accompanying schedule of findings and questioned costs as items 2024-001 and 2024-002, to be significant deficiencies.

Our audit was not designed for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of internal control over compliance. Accordingly, no such opinion is expressed.

Government Auditing Standards requires the auditor to perform limited procedures on the County's response to the internal control over compliance findings identified in our compliance audit described in the accompanying schedule of findings and questioned costs. The County's response was not subjected to the other auditing procedures applied in the audit of compliance and, accordingly, we express no opinion on the response.

The purpose of this report on internal control over compliance is solely to describe the scope of our testing of internal control over compliance and the results of that testing based on the requirements of the Uniform Guidance and the *Guidelines*. Accordingly, this report is not suitable for any other purpose.

Report on Schedules of Expenditures of Federal and State Awards Required by the Uniform Guidance and the *Guidelines*

We have audited the financial statements of the governmental activities, the business-type activities, the aggregate discretely presented component units, each major fund, and the aggregate remaining fund information of the County as of and for the year ended December 31, 2024, and the related notes to the financial statements, which collectively comprise the County's basic financial statements. We issued our report thereon dated July 31, 2025, which contained unmodified opinions on those financial statements. Our audit was conducted for the purpose of forming opinions on the financial statements that collectively comprise the basic financial statements. The accompanying schedules of expenditures of federal and state awards are presented for purposes of additional analysis as required by the Uniform Guidance and the Guidelines and are not a required part of the basic financial statements. Such information is the responsibility of management and was derived from and relates directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the basic financial statements. The information has been subjected to the auditing procedures applied in the audit of the basic financial statements and certain additional procedures, including comparing and reconciling such information directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the basic financial statements or to the basic financial statements themselves, and other additional procedures in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. In our opinion, the schedules of expenditures of federal and state awards are fairly stated in all material respects in relation to the basic financial statements as a whole.

NOTES TO SCHEDULES OF EXPENDITURES OF FEDERAL AND STATE AWARDS

YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2024

1. **SCOPE OF AUDIT**

The County of Milwaukee (County) is a governmental entity established by laws of the State of Wisconsin and has the powers of a body corporate, as defined in the Statutes. All significant operations of the County are included in the scope of the Single Audit in accordance with the provisions of Title 2 U.S. Code of Federal Regulations Part 200, Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards (Uniform Guidance), and the State Single Audit Guidelines issued by the State of Wisconsin, Department of Administration. The U.S. Department of Transportation has been designated as the County's cognizant agency for the Single Audit.

(a) Programs Subject to Single Audit

All Federal awards received by the County directly from the Federal government or passed through the State of Wisconsin have been included in the Schedules of Expenditures of Federal Awards. All State Awards received by the County have been included in the Schedules of Expenditures of State Awards.

(b) Fiscal Period Audited

Single Audit testing procedures were performed for program transactions occurring during the calendar year ended December 31, 2024.

2. **SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

(a) Accrued and Deferred Balances

Revenues (which include grantor reimbursement and local funding) are reported on the cash basis of accounting, whereas expenditures are reported on the accrual basis. The difference between the reported revenues and expenditures can result in accrued or deferred balances at the end of the year. These balances are reversed in subsequent periods.

The following statement applies to the Department of Health and Human Services – Housing Division, Department of Parks, Recreation and Culture, Sheriff Department, Department of Administrative Services – Architecture and Engineering Services, Office of Emergency Management, Department of Transportation - Transit System, and the Clerk of Circuit Courts.

The 2024 Single Audit Report identifies corrections necessary to the beginning balance reported in 2024 from the ending balance in the 2023 Single Audit Report. Each project contains the 2023 ending balance reported in 2023, the adjusted amount for the correction and the correct amount at the start of 2024. As these balances reverse in subsequent years, making this one-time adjustment brings all the projects in line for the end of 2024.

(b) Sub grantees

Certain program funds are passed through the County to subgrantee organizations. The Schedules of Expenditures of Federal and State Awards do not contain separate schedules disclosing how the subgrantees outside of the County's control utilized the funds. The County requires subgrantees receiving funding to submit separate audit reports disclosing the use of program funds.

(c) <u>Cost Allocation</u>

The County has a plan for allocation of central service costs related to grant programs. The amounts allocated to grant programs during a fiscal year are based on this cost allocation plan. Variances between actual costs and budgeted amounts are corrected on a prospective basis. As a result, the 2024 Cost Allocation Plan was based on the 2022 actual amounts and includes adjustments for variances between the 2022 Plan and the 2022 actual amounts.

In addition to the cost allocation plan, the County has various departments, which provide services to other County departments. Charges between departments are based upon direct rates. The methodology or basis for these direct rates has been reviewed and approved by representatives of the Federal Transportation Administration – Department of Transportation.

(d) **De Minimis Election**

Milwaukee County has elected not to use the applicable de minimis cost rate.

3. **SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION**

(a) Title XIX Medical Assistance payments to the Behavioral Health Division for 2024 and 2023 amounted to \$90,922,405 and \$95,633,366 respectively. These amounts consisted of the following items:

- (b) Program income was received mainly in the form of principal and interest payments from home rehabilitation loans to lower-income occupants. The original home repair loans were funded by Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) and Home Investment Partnership (HOME), which originated from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. CDBG and HOME program income of \$77,089 and \$59,434 respectively was received from these loans in 2024.
- (c) According to the State of Wisconsin, Department of Children and Families, 2024 Youth Aids-State payments for correctional facility charges were \$7,374,444. This amount is unaudited and is presented as additional information to satisfy disclosure requirements established by the State of Wisconsin, Department of Health and Family Services.

Criteria: Per 2 CFR §200.430 - Compensation—personal services, charges to Federal awards for salaries and wages must be based on records that accurately reflect the work performed, are properly supported, and are consistent with the entity's accounting records. Additionally, 2 CFR §200.303 - Internal Controls requires non-Federal entities to establish and maintain effective internal controls that provide reasonable assurance of compliance with Federal statutes, regulations, and terms and conditions of Federal awards.

Condition/Context: As part of our testing procedures over payroll, we reconciled amounts recorded on the Payroll Ledger to the General Ledger for each payroll sample that we tested. From a sample of 40, we noted two instances where the amounts recorded in the General Ledger did not agree with the corresponding amounts recorded in the Payroll Ledger. Our sample was not statistically valid.

Effect: Inaccurate or unsupported recording of payroll costs increases the risk that unallowable or misstated payroll expenses may be charged to Federal awards. If not corrected, this could result in inaccurate financial reporting and potential questioned costs.

Questioned Costs: None noted.

Cause: Payroll Ledger records are generated from programmatic reports based on timesheet entries in the county's Dayforce system. While manual adjustments or allocations of programmatic reports to the Payroll Ledger are sometimes made before these records are ultimately posted to the General Ledger, no formal reconciliations are performed to account for these changes. As a result, discrepancies between the programmatic reports and the General Ledger are likely whenever there are adjustments or allocations in the programmatic reports which are not posted on the General Ledger.

Recommendation: We recommend that management strengthen internal controls over payroll reconciliations by:

- Implementing a system review process to ensure Payroll Ledger amounts reconcile to the General Ledger.
- Conducting periodic reconciliations between the programmatic reports, Payroll Ledger and General Ledger and promptly investigating any discrepancies.
- Providing training to accounting personnel on proper reconciliation procedures.

Schedule of Findings and Questioned Costs Year Ended December 31, 2024

Views of Responsible Officials: Dayforce is configured to allocate salary expenses to an employee's home agency and department, regardless of where the employee assigns their hours in the timekeeping system. While the timesheet programmatic reflects the agency and department where hours and dollars are functionally charged, the payroll register aligns with the General Ledger based on home agency coding. As a result, the Payroll Register and General Ledger will reconcile with each other but may not align with programmatic reports, which are based on timesheet-level allocations. This system behavior is consistent with current configuration and financial reporting practices.

Criteria: 2 CFR §200.303 - Internal Controls and the *State Single Audit Guidelines* requires non-Federal entities to maintain effective internal control over Federal and state awards, including documented review and approval of payroll records.

Condition/Context: During our testing of payroll expenses, we observed that payroll records for two employees from a sample of 40 that we tested were processed without documented evidence of management approval of their timesheets before processing of payroll. Our sample was not statistically valid.

Effect: Processing payroll without proper supervisory approval increases the risk of inaccurate or unallowable payroll charges being recorded and charged to state awards, and may result in noncompliance with state requirements.

Questioned Costs: None noted.

Cause: There was a change in management oversight and the payroll system and management responsible for approvals was not updated in a timely manner. As a result, payroll was processed without proper approval.

Recommendation: We recommend that management enforce policies requiring documented supervisory approval of all employee timesheets prior to payroll processing. Management should also implement periodic monitoring to confirm compliance with established procedures, specifically during times of position turnover.

Views of Responsible Officials: There was a change in management oversight for the employees in question; however, the 'Management Assignment' field in Dayforce was not updated in a timely manner to reflect the new reporting structure. Steps have since been taken to improve internal communication and ensure that management changes are promptly reflected in Dayforce moving forward.
