A report from the Director, Department of Health and Human Services, requesting authorization to execute a 2025 professional service contract totaling \$19,500 with Jennifer Lefeber to coordinate and facilitate Evidence-Based Disease Prevention and Health Promotion Programs (EBPP), by recommending adoption of the following:

## A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Area Agency on Aging (AAA) is mandated to provide a variety of evidence-based disease prevention and health promotion (EBPP) activities by Title III-D, Older Americans Act, to support older adult healthy lifestyles and behaviors; and

WHEREAS, EBPP is overseen by the Wisconsin Institute for Healthy Aging and addresses topics of concern to older adults, including diabetes, heart disease, chronic pain management, and caregiver support in a manner that is research-based and demonstrated to improve quality of life; and

WHEREAS, Jennifer Lefeber has increased outreach to train and recruit new facilitators to deliver programming from a variety of partners and neighborhoods within Milwaukee County to rebuild the network after the Coronavirus Disease pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) has identified population health and systems change as a strategy, which includes encouraging healthy behaviors; and

WHEREAS, based upon satisfactory performance, DHHS wishes to renew its contract with Ms. Lefeber for an amount of \$19,500 for the First Quarter of 2025; and

WHEREAS, the aggregate value of this contract exceeds \$300,000; and

WHEREAS, consistent with Section 59.52(31)(c), Wisconsin State Statutes, DHHS, must, on behalf of the Commission on Aging, bring contracts with a value or aggregate value of \$300,000 or more to the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors for authorization; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of December 12, 2024, recommended adoption of File No. 24-913 (vote 7-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director, Department of Health and Human Services, or her designee, to execute a 2025 Professional Services Contract with Jennifer Lefeber in the amount of
