Programing continues with evidence-based prevention workshops, virtual and mail-in tool-kits. The contract continues the goal for 2023 to increase enrollment participation and training new instructors for evidence-based classes.

  - C. This agreement is included in the 2023 Budget so there is no tax levy impact.
