Lease of portions of the Zoo to operate a food service and merchandising business - This includes operating and maintaining permanent and mobile food concession facilities; establishing vendor concessions and catering operations; managing warehouse operations, retail stores, and retail vending; positioning mobile units; establishing newly conceived merchandising operations; and using storage, closets, and office space to sell food and retail merchandise that relates to the Zoo and its mission, promotes public awareness of the Zoo, and is customary and reasonable for the convenience of Zoo visitors. SSA may use existing equipment and furnishings related to food service and merchandising. SSA shall pay monthly rent (a percentage of gross receipts on concession food, beverage, vending, retail gifts, and external catering food, beverage, and alcohol); provide a marketing fund for the first five years; donate catering to the County to support fundraising; invest in capital improvements for start-up costs (including purchasing any remaining merchandise), alterations, furnishings, and equipment; hire the three existing key Zoo employees; and, if Zoo attendance exceeds 1.2 million visitors in a calendar year, pay a guaranteed amount. The Zoo will coordinate all internal and external events and sales of external events including catering and facility rentals, security, custodial, audio-visual, educational programming, and interpretive guide services. County shall continue to designate approved caterers for facility rentals or catering contracts; users may select any approved caterer to provide food service only while SSA will provide beverage service. SSA is designated an approved caterer.
