 9 WHEREAS Housing Division of the Department of Health and Human Services
 10 has begun to form partnerships with local Health Management Organizations (HMOs)
 11 interested in the Housing First philosophy; and
 12

13 WHEREAS the HMOs are willing to pay for the cost of housing for HMO
 14 participants; and
 15

16 WHEREAS the HMOs are willing to pay for all costs related to 2.0 FTEs
 17 Community Intervention Specialists within the Housing Division of the Department of
 18 Health and Human Services in order to provide navigation of housing services for their
 19 qualifying members; and
 20

21 WHEREAS the Housing Division is under capacity issues and serving additional
 22 referrals from HMOs requires additional resources, including time and effort in the form
 23 of employee related capital,
 24

25 WHEREAS additional staff capacity is necessary to properly assist additional
 26 people referred by HMOs and maintain current administrative operational demands and
 27 requirements; now therefore,

29 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby
 30 authorizes and approves the following position action for the Department of Health and
 31 Human Services – Housing Division, effective June 14, 2018.

 36 Specialist positions will only be created and funded provided that a signed agreement
 37 with the partner HMOs stipulates that the HMOs will cover all of the costs associated
 38 with these positions; and the 2.0 FTE Community Intervention Specialist positions will
 39 be abolished upon loss of funding.
