



AN ORDINANCE

The Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 3.D1 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

3.D1 - Appointment of county board.

(1) Establishment of county board districts. In order to maintain the integrity of the representative process and to mitigate any burdens of travel or expense of a citizen to attend an independent redistricting committee (IRC) that is established by this Code, and shall be established in accordance with the law established pursuant to 2021 S.B. 220 (the "Local Redistricting Compact and Voting Rights Act"), hereinafter referred to as the "Compact," to develop all subsequent congressional redistricting plans for Milwaukee County.

(2) Creation of supervisory districts. The county board establishes 10 supervisory districts to represent its constituents on the basis of population, but not necessarily along either state or county boundaries, in order to promote the representation of minority and community and geographic integrity of a voting village and city lines and precincts where applicable, and with the recommendation of the independent redistricting plan and good faith effort to do so in a geographically contiguous manner.

(3) Incorporated areas. The IRC's recommendation shall comply with the following criteria:

(a) Fairness and equality in mandates.

(b) Promoting criteria established by federal and state laws.

(c) Maintenance of voting rights of Hispanic and African American and other ethnic groups as presented in the Voting Rights Act of 1965.

(d) A map that consists of census tracts that take into account the integrity of existing neighborhoods and communities of interest within Milwaukee County.

(e) Minority. The IRC shall be comprised of six (6) elected judges appointed by the county board, confirmation and confirmation by the County Board, who are familiar with Milwaukee County, and maintain a Wisconsin state license in practice.

Working

(f) Comment period for community groups. There shall be a comment period no less than sixty (60) days for specified community groups to submit written feedback regarding the qualifications to the county board chairperson's office. The county board chairperson shall send copies of the submitted (IRC member) resumes and appointment letters to the following organizations no less than sixty (60) days prior to confirmation:

(1) Marquette University Law School

(2) University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee School of Public Administration

(3) The Hispanic Chamber of Commerce

(4) The Milwaukee Urban League

(5) The Public Policy Forum

(6) The Intergovernmental Cooperation Council of Milwaukee

Area

(7) The League of Women Voters

(8) The NAACP

(9) Voice-De La Rendene.

(g) Resources. Milwaukee County shall provide an accessible meeting space and non-discriminatory funding for the committee to complete its tasks in a timely manner, including financial support to the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission (SEWRPC) to provide the necessary technical assistance and map drafting services as determined by the IRC to carry out its objectives.

(h) Compensation. Members of the IRC shall be compensated in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or a comparable rate to those who serve on similar public committees. This compensation shall only be offered for services rendered during the time frame in which the decimal redistricting process is conducted.

(i) Appointment of supervisory districts. Eighteen (18) supervisory districts are to be established as 10 county supervisory districts for the spring primary in February 2021 and spring election in April 2021 and are to remain in effect until the 2020 federal decennial population distribution is finalized, or unless and until the number of supervisory districts changes. A county board resolution will be submitted in tandem with the establishment of the 2020 federal decennial population census and thereafter to set the number of supervisory districts established in the recommended county-wide map.

(j) Primary. The IRC shall be appointed no later than July 1 in the year 2021, the end of September in the year 2020, 2020 and every decennial period thereafter.

(k) The IRC, as convened at a time as practicable after the U.S. decennial census data is prepared and available to the County. The IRC may elect to convene prior to the publication of the U.S. decennial census data. The IRC will meet no less than once a month, thereafter publication of the U.S. decennial census data and a first draft of a county redistricting map is presented to the county board; no later than May of the year after appointment.

(l) Adoption of the map. The county board shall have a simple majority of the members to be seated. The map and any substantiating data produced by the IRC shall be voted on by the county board.

(m) If the county board does not adopt the proposed map within thirty (30) days, the map shall return to the IRC for review and refining of a second map, including public and elected official comment.

(n) The IRC is required to adopt a map if any shall be returned to the county board within (30) days. If the county board does not adopt it a proposed final map within (30) days, the county board shall proceed in developing and adopt a map directly without further IRC participation, following the procedure in § 9.102(h)(6) WIS. Stats., paragraph 2, or 3.

(o) The IRC is third party of the map, shall be retained by the county board within (30) days.
