("CMSI") and Prism Technical Management & Marketing Services, LLC ("Prism Technical" or "Prism"), are dedicated to ensuring the projects are successful and meet or exceed the goals described herein.

This report provides information on the inclusion achieved for professional services, construction and workforce¹ compliance on the 5th Street Parking Structure ("Parking Structure"), Froedtert & the Medical College of Wisconsin Sports Science Center ("F & MCW Sports Science Center"), and McKinley Health Center through December 31, 2017. Collectively, the Parking Structure, McKinley Health Center,

Through December 31, 2017, the Projects awarded contracts valued at \$1,908,916 or 28.6% of professional services cost subject to inclusion and \$19,046,040 or 30.2% of the construction cost subject to inclusion, and Milwaukee County Residents have performed 37.8% of the construction hours.

and F & MCW Sports Science Center are referred to herein as the "Projects." The inclusion requirements^{2,3} were established in the PERC Agreement with Milwaukee County, which requires 17% Targeted Enterprise ("TE") professional services inclusion, 25% TE construction inclusion, 25% Milwaukee County Residents inclusion, 15% apprentice inclusion, and payment of prevailing wages.





JOBS INFORMATIONAL SESSION – HILLSIDE RESOURCE CENTER

Alderwoman Milele A. Coggs and the Milwaukee Bucks hosted a community workforce session to discuss career opportunities upon completion of the Milwaukee Bucks Arena Projects. Over 50 attendees learned the process to become employed for the Bucks project, and also used on-site computers to create a SkillSmart account and talk to representatives regarding Residents Preference Program certification. SkillSmart registered 1,532 potential candidates into their online database and 76.2% of those candidates were City of Milwaukee residents.




WORKER HIGHLIGHT: BRIAN STROTHERS












