9	WHEREAS, in June 2012, Milwaukee Transport Services (MTS), which operates
10	the Milwaukee County Transit System (MCTS) through a contractual agreement with
11	the County, issued a request for proposals (RFP) for paratransit services beginning
12	November 1, 2012; and
13	VALUEDEAC and another company company with NATO the Nathanauleae County
14	WHEREAS, under the current arrangement with MTS, the Milwaukee County
15	Board of Supervisors does not review or approve transit service contracts, including
16	paratransit services; and
17 18	WHEREAS, a March 17, 2013, article in the Milwaukee Journal Sentinel,
19	outlined a flawed procurement process for paratransit services in 2012 that eventually
20	led to a three-year emergency contract that purportedly will cost taxpayers \$8.6 million
21	more than the original bids over the life of the contract; and

23	WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors supports an audit of the
24	2012 paratransit service contract entered into by MTS on behalf of the MCTS to better
25	understand the facts surrounding the procurement of paratransit services, including the
26	financial implications, and consider any recommended improvements to the process
