(ITEM ) From the Director, Department of Child Support Services, requesting authorization to execute Children First contract extensions (amendment no. 3) with United Migrant Opportunity Services, Inc., Center for Veterans Issues, and My Father's House in the total amount of \$370,800 to provide case management and program activities for the period effective January 1, 2016, through December 31, 2016, by recommending adoption of the following:

**A RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, Milwaukee County (the County) through the State of Wisconsin has Children First funding to assist participants in achieving self-sufficiency under Section 767.55 and Section 49.36, Wisconsin State Statutes; and

WHEREAS, each Children First contractor site facilitates case referrals and Children First activities, including, but not limited to employability plans; and

WHEREAS, the contracts provide that contractors assist the County in collection of child support obligations with services provided to support payers; and

WHEREAS, the contractors will be entitled to payment of \$400 per participant enrolled in the Children First Program in a 12-month period; and

WHEREAS, the term of the contract shall be from January 1, 2016, through December 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the contracting agencies include: United Migrant Opportunity Services, Inc., Center for Veterans Issues, and My Father's House; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, Personnel, and Audit, at its meeting of December 10, 2015, recommended adoption of the Director's request (vote 5-0-1); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Finance, Personnel, and Audit Committee, and Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director, Department of Child Support Services, to extend the contracts with United Migrant Opportunity Services, Inc., Center for Veterans Issues, and My Father's House to provide Children First case management and program activities to payers ordered into the program.
