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From the Chief Judge, First Judicial District, requesting authorization to increase an existing Professional Services Contract with JusticePoint, Inc., by \$60,000, from \$3,649,707 to \$3,709,707, using 2017 encumbered funds, for a validation study of the Public Safety Assessment, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors adopted the 2018 Budget on November 6, 2017 (File No. 17-674), which included contracting with JusticePoint, Inc., for Pretrial Services for the period effective January 1, 2018, to December 31, 2018; and

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2016, Pretrial Services implemented the Laura and John Arnold Foundation’s Public Safety Assessment (PSA) to provide pretrial risk assessment and release recommendations to the Court; and

WHEREAS, the Courts desire to assess how the current pretrial system is performing; and

WHEREAS, JusticePoint, Inc., will contract with Luminosity, Inc., to complete a four-phase assessment of Milwaukee County’s pretrial system, including stakeholder engagement sessions, and a validation study of the PSA; and

WHEREAS, Phase I will include qualitative and quantitative assessments along with a quality assurance audit; and

WHEREAS, Phase II will include data analysis and summary of system assessment findings; and

WHEREAS, Phase III will include development of recommendations based on the system assessment findings; and

WHEREAS, Phase IV will include a report and presentation of the system assessment findings and strategizing for next steps; and

WHEREAS, the additional \$60,000 would come from 2017 encumbered funds; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance and Audit, at its meeting of March 15, 2018, recommended adoption of File No. 18-215 (vote 7-0); now, therefore,
