REQUEST

Abolish one (1) FTE Safety Program Manager DOT and create one (1) FTE Senior Safety Specialist in the Department of Administrative Services - Risk Management.

POLICY

BACKGROUND

The incumbent has recently retired. As a result, Risk Management has reevaluated the position requirements and submitted a revised JEQ to the Department of Human Resources. This abolish/create action will create a better career advancement structure within the Risk Management division and will also allow the newly created position of Senior Safety Specialist to be assigned to any appropriate worksite throughout Milwaukee County, providing greater flexibility to meet business needs. In contrast, the position to be abolished was required to work only at DOT and meet qualifications for the same.

By abolishing the Safety Program Manager DOT and creating the Senior Safety

Specialist, Risk Management will be able to recruit more inclusively for this position, allowing for recruitment outside of those interested in working only at DOT. Additionally, this position change action has created a position in a lower salary range, which may result in a reduction in salary costs, addressing the fiscal health and sustainability of Milwaukee County.

FISCAL EFFECT

It is anticipated the newly created Senior Safety Specialist will be hired mid to late October of 2025. The salary savings per year based on the midpoint of the salary range is approximately \$14,543, excluding social security.
