# **Community Support Expenditure Category**

- In March 2023, the Milwaukee County Community Support subgroups completed their tasks to make funding recommendations within the Community Support expenditure category.
- Three projects are pending Milwaukee County Board of Supervisor approval:
  - Sherman Park Reimagined (\$962,303)
  - UpStart Kitchen (\$412,500)
  - MENTOR Greater Milwaukee (\$262,500)
- Two projects are pending Milwaukee County Health Board approval:
  - Access to Mental Health Care (\$262,500)
  - Mental Health Clinic for Youth & Young Adults (\$200,524)



# Community Support Project Update: Milwaukee Market Match



#### Milwaukee Market Match

- Funding Amount: \$1,100,000
- Total Cumulative Expenditures: \$91,358
- Main Activities
  - Increases the purchase and consumption of locally grown fruits and vegetables by accepting SNAP/EBT (FoodShare) benefits at Milwaukee County Farmers Markets
  - Provides matching dollars to individuals and families participating in FoodShare to purchase additional fruits and vegetables
  - Wisconsin grown produce is made more affordable by doubling the customer's transaction



#### Milwaukee Market Match

- Project Updates
  - Contract went into effect on July 1, 2022
  - SNAP participants began having their Fruit and Vegetable purchases matched in August of 2022
  - For 2022, \$108,102 were directly matched to SNAP participants fruit and vegetable purchases



#### Revenue Loss Recovery Subgroup Updates:

- The Revenue Loss Recovery Subgroup recommends ARPA funding for a full-time position for the Department of Administration Procurement. This position was recommended by the Finance Committee and approved in the 2023 budget cycle.
- Revenue Loss Recovery projects will be considered through the 2024 the annual capital request process.
- Requests are due no later than July 14, 2023.

# **COVID-19 Mitigation Updates**

- As of March 30, 2023, the subgroup has received 30 requests for COVID-19 mitigation funds.
  - 17 of the projects are currently open
  - 7 projects have been concluded
  - 6 projects were not eligible for COVID-19 Mitigation funding
- The COVID-19 Mitigation subgroup has approved \$2,639,242 in expenses.
- SBP submitted a total of \$2,322,291 of 2020-2022 COVID-19 Mitigation expenses for FEMA reimbursement. Claims are currently under review by FEMA.
- SBP plans to submit a final FEMA claim for remaining 2022 and 2023 eligible COVID-19 mitigation expenses by May 11, 2023.

# **Fund Administration Updates**

- The SBP Project Management Office (PMO) will create a financial tracking dashboard using ARPA quarterly cumulative reporting as well as a project status dashboard.
- The PMO will submit the first quarter 2023 report to the U.S. Department of Treasury on April 29, 2023.
- The Evaluation Request for Proposals (RFP) for Phase One of the ARPA Evaluation Plan closed on March 24, 2023. Below is a timeline for selecting a Phase I Evaluator:
  - April 2023: Preliminary Evaluations (County Internal) and Evaluator Training. The Milwaukee County Review Committee will evaluate submissions based on criteria established in the RFP.
  - May 2023: Milwaukee County will schedule interviews with potential evaluators if needed. The Milwaukee County Review Committee will complete final scoring.
  - June 2023: Phase I Evaluator will be selected. Recommendation will be shared with the ARPA Task Force
  - July 2023: The Phase I Evaluation contract will follow board process for approval.
