Background

- Department of Health and Human Services "No Wrong Door" customer service approach
- Closure of Behavioral Health complex on Watertown Plank Road
- County Board approval of transfer of \$32,335,694 in ARPA "Revenue Loss Recovery" funds into allocated contingency in capital project WS0126
- New 60,000± square foot building, estimated construction cost of \$42.2 million
- New facility avoids investment of \$45+ million in renovations and deferred maintenance costs, as well as an inefficient, more than half empty facility

Current Project Development Status




- Four story, 60,000± square foot building
- Located in existing Milwaukee County parking lot north of W.
 Cherry Street
- Located close to most impacted Milwaukee County population
- Adjacency to Mental Health Emergency Center
- DHHS investment of \$10 million (approx. 100 homes) in housing within King Center neighborhood

Future of Existing Coggs Facility

- Little utility for continued County purposes
- Underutilized space becomes a financial liability
- Could be an attractive property for acquisition and redevelopment
- DAS-Economic Development staff solicited proposals for redevelopment

Next steps

- 1. Proceed with design and pre-construction activities
- 2. Review options for existing Coggs building
- Identify additional funding needs and include as necessary in 2024 capital budget request process
