# 3. Resolution to create individual district pages on the Youth Commission website (Action Item)

Proposed: The Youth Commission requests that the Office of Strategy, Budget, & Performance adds individual district pages to the Youth Commission website and provides a template to Youth Commissioners to provide content for their district pages by June 30, 2024.

# 4. Resolution to add two youth community members to planning committees to advance action plans (Action Item)

Proposed: Allow two youth community members to serve on one of the two planning committees to advance the action plans of both standing committees. The planning committees will meet virtually on non-standing committee meeting months. Youth Commissioners on each standing committee will be asked to volunteer to serve on their respective planning committee with committee leaders being required to serve.

An application to serve as a community member on one of the planning committees will be posted on the Youth Commission website. Each committee will consider and vote on applications using objective criteria (TBD).
