PASSIVE REVIEW - ITEMS 15, 16, and 17

Act 14 provides for a 14-day review period by the Finance and Audit (F&A) Committee for all contracts with a value of at least \$100,000, but not more than \$300,000. The contract may take effect only upon one of the following: The 14-day review period expired with no action by the F&A Committee, or The F&A Committee reviewed the item and placed it on file within the 14-day review

> period, or The F&A Committee voted to approve the contract during the 14-day review period, or The F&A Committee voted to reject it within the 14-day review period, but, within 30 days of the Committee action, the County Board votes to approve it.
