CA50 Guiding Principles

1. Create Intentional Inclusion

1a: Identify and involve Milwaukee County stakeholders and partners in each phase of the plan.

1b: Increase involvement of minority and women-owned businesses with plan implementation.

2. Bridge Gap

2a: Identify health disparities caused by climate change and prioritize actions that will positively impact health outcomes.

3. Invest in Equity

3a: Align actions with Milwaukee County's mission, priorities, and core functions.

3b: Prioritize actions that will provide green education and jobs for underserved communities.

Vision: Milwaukee County will achieve net zero carbon emissions while advancing equity, justice & resilience.

Mission & Goals: Provide roadmap for County to:

- Achieve carbon neutral county operations by 2050;
- Improve resiliency to climate change; and
- Align climate actions w/ County's Vision.
