### **REQUEST**

Milwaukee County File #21-526 adopted a name change for the park located at 3629 N. 16<sup>th</sup> street from Lindbergh Park to Lucille Berrien Park and requested an informational report from the Milwaukee County Parks Department on the status for removal of the deed restriction and concurrent release of funds for new signage.

## **BACKGROUND**

File #21-526 adopted a name change for the park located at 3629 N. 16<sup>th</sup> street from Lindbergh Park to Lucille Berrien Park. The park was deeded from the City of Milwaukee to Milwaukee County in 1936 with certain restrictions including use and names. In 2001 the City of Milwaukee revised the deed restrictions to provide for name changes by resolution of the Milwaukee Common Council. After passage of the county resolution 21-526 Milwaukee County Parks engaged with the City of Milwaukee to effectuate approval by the City of Milwaukee Common Council for the name change. Milwaukee Common Council File #210464 approving the name change for the park was approved by the Common Council on July 27, 2021and certified by the City Clerk on August 10, 2021.
