- A. The Director of the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) is requesting authorization to sign a 2022 Social Services and Community Programs contract with the State Department of Health Services (DHS). Approval will allow Milwaukee County to receive State revenue for county services to persons with disabilities and their families, older adults as well as those in need of community support and prevention services as mandated by State and/or Federal law.
- B. The state's Social Services and Community Programs contract includes various separate revenues used to fund DHHS. Approval to sign the 2022 contract will allow Milwaukee County to receive funds.
- C. The actual 2022 "Community Aids" contract for DHHS provides an allocation totaling \$17,193,695; this amount is \$78,715 more than the \$17,114,980 included in the DHHS 2022 Budget primarily due to increased funding for Alzheimer Caregiver Support and a variety of Title 3 funding increases offset by less Children's Long Term Support (CLTS) Program administration revenue due to a lagging assumption on the number of children being served in the program.
- D. No further assumptions are made. The fiscal information was taken from the DHS 2022 contract notification.
