 - A. <u>DHHS is requesting authorization to execute a 2022 purchase of service contract between</u> <u>First Transit, Inc. and the Milwaukee County DHHS Division on Aging to provide</u> <u>transportation for older adults.</u>
 - B. <u>The contract amount is \$1,500,000 and the 2022 approved budget includes sufficient funding for this contract. Revenue to fund this program includes Wis. Stats. §85.21 Specialized Transportation Services for the Elderly allocation (\$652,000), Older Americans Act Title III-B federal funds (\$257,458), and Basic County Allocation (\$549,612). Support also anticipates the use of Older American Act ARPA funds (\$40,930) pending formal award letter from the State.</u>
 - C. <u>Specialized Transportation for older adults is an ongoing program.</u> During the COVID-19 pandemic, rides have been exclusively for single riders as opposed to group <u>transportation.</u>
 - D. Assumes 2022 Budget Adopted is as requested.
