This report authorizes the Director, Department of Health and Human Services, to increase the 2021 contract with American United Transportation (AUT) by \$25,000 for transportation and delivery costs of meals to seniors of Milwaukee county who can no longer dine at congregate meal sites.

The increase is funded through American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding of 2021-2022. No assumptions were made in providing the information on this fiscal note.

This AUT contract amendment has no net fiscal impact in 2021 other than the allocation of staff time required to prepare the accompanying report and resolution.
