



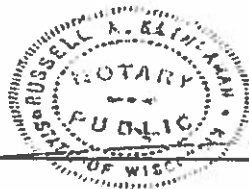

AN ORDINANCE

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 17.14(21) of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is amended as follows:

17.14 Employment definitions.

(21) *Call-in pay.* Employees, who are not exempt from the Fair Labor Standards Act (except hourly, seasonal, and interns), and who are called in to work outside of the employee's regularly scheduled shift, ~~whether on standby or not~~, shall be paid a minimum of four (4) hours pay at the regular ~~overtime~~ rate for work in one session and ~~additional pay at the overtime rate when such hours exceed 40 hours worked in the week.~~ Call-in pay shall not apply to hours worked outside of an employee's regularly scheduled shift where the regular shift starting time is modified to meet emergency situations.

SECTION 2. The provisions of this ordinance shall be effective on May 19, 2019.
