From the Directors of the Department of Health and Human Services and the Department of Administrative Services requesting release of funds held in an allocated contingency account within capital project WS12601 - Youth Services Admin Relocation and Tenant Improvements, by recommending adoption of the following:

## A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), and the Facilities Management Division, Department of Administrative Services (FMD-DAS), have been working together for over two years to strategize and plan a relocation of DHHS administrative staff from the Behavioral Health Division (BHD) Mental Health Complex, Marcia P. Coggs Human Services Center (Coggs Center), and the Vel Phillips Youth and Family Justice Center, in support of the DHHS "No Wrong Door" approach to customer service, which is guiding the facility-related decisions; and

WHEREAS, for over a year, DHHS worked with FMD-DAS to identify an alternative location to the Coggs Center, and reviewed a number of long-term lease options and buildout plans with DHHS leadership, and ultimately the decision was made to remain at the Coggs Center as described in File No. 21-799; and

WHEREAS, the original impetus for relocating from the Coggs Center was the building's lack of accessibility, and this concern remains unchanged and is now the focus of a redesign effort being undertaken by FMD-DAS and its space consultant; and

WHEREAS, the Coggs Center has been a long-recognized location for providing and receiving community services, and the decision to consolidate DHHS staff at the Coggs Center while investing in the building is well aligned with Milwaukee County strategic focus areas, as well as the DHHS strategic plan; and

WHEREAS, as part of the 2021 Adopted Capital Improvements Budget, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) adopted Amendment 1B005, requiring that a written plan detailing the project scope and location be submitted to the County Board for review, prior to the release of approximately \$4.7 million in funds being held in an allocated contingency account, to support a portion of the costs of this project; and

WHEREAS, the information requested by the County Board has been provided as part of this file, as well as File No. 21-799; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of December 9, 2021, recommended adoption of File No. 21-1035 (vote 7-0); now, therefore,

 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby
authorizes the Office of Performance, Strategy, and Budget, Department of
Administrative Services, and the Office of the Comptroller, to release \$4,663,816 in
funds from the allocated contingency account into Capital Project WS12601 – Youth
Services Administration Relocation and Tenant Improvements.
