A Request from the Director, Department of Administrative Services (DAS), regarding

Authorization to Execute a Professional Services Agreement Exceeding \$300,000 for

Capital Project WP071800-Domes Mesh Inspection and Repairs resulting in a lump

sum Not-to-Exceed contract value of \$317,430.00, by recommending adoption of the

WHEREAS, approximately five years ago, a temporary stainless steel mesh system was installed in the three domes of the Mitchell Park Horticultural Conservatory (the Domes), with the intent of capturing spalls from the Domes' concrete structure; and

WHEREAS, the design consultant of this temporary stainless steel mesh system had recommended an inspection of the Dome structures and mesh system at the five-year anniversary of the mesh system's installation; and

WHEREAS, a Consultant Agreement is being extended to ZS Architectural Engineering, LLC, for professional services for Capital Project WP0718011, Domes Mesh Inspection and Repairs (Capital Project WP0718011), resulting in a lump sum not–to-exceed contract value of \$317,430; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work for the Consultant Agreement for Capital Project WP0718011 shall generally include inspection of the mesh system, inspection of the Domes' concrete structures, repair to mesh system and/or the Domes' concrete structure, development, and testing of a glazing system mock-up as a potential replacement for the Domes' glazing system; and

WHEREAS, the recommendation and development of a glazing system mock-up was included in the scope of work for Capital Project WP0684011, Domes Material Testing (Capital Project WP0684011); and

WHEREAS, funds have been transferred from Capital Project WP0684011 to Capital Project WP0718011, for development and testing of a glazing system mock-up; and

WHEREAS, the selection of ZS Architectural Engineering, LLC, for Capital Project WP0718011 without utilizing a Request for Proposal (RFP) solicitation provided benefits to Milwaukee County (the County); and

WHEREAS, ZS Architectural Engineering, LLC, is currently active in Capital Project WP0684011; and

 WHEREAS, the involvement of ZS Architectural Engineering, LLC, in both Capital Projects WP0718011, and WP0684011 will have benefits to the County, including reducing down time to the Domes, providing an economy with both projects utilizing the same specialized lift, initiating the project sooner by forgoing RFP solicitation, and utilizing the same subcontractor that provided the original installation of the existing mesh system; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of December 9, 2021, recommended adoption of File No. 21-1054 (vote 7-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to Section 59.21(31), Wisconsin State Statutes, and Chapter 56, Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the execution of a Consultant Agreement with ZS Architectural Engineering, LLC, for a Professional Services Agreement for Capital Project WP0718011, Domes Mesh Inspection and Repairs, resulting in a lump sum not-to-exceed contract value of \$317,430.
