In making the determination whether to conduct an autopsy or, after deciding to conduct an autopsy, when making the determination of the cause and manner of death, the Medical Examiner shall utilize all information of whatever kind that a reasonable Medical Examiner would utilize the same or similar committee. under the same or similar circum-

(2):(a) in order to fulfill the responsibility set forth in paragraph (1), the Medical Examiner shall request any medical examiner shall reduest any and all reports available from known or involved sgencles of persons including any and all relevant and available video or audio recordings.
