The Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee does ordein as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 32 of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is amended as follows:

22.28. Emergency purchases: immodiate

restricted limitations: - If required. Initiated in accordance

32.33. - Encumbrance of funds.

Except for an emergency as identified in cection 32.28, aNo order for supplies, materials, equipment or contractual services shall be awarded until the division of fiscal affairs certifies that the unencumbered balance in the appropriation(s) concerned is sufficient to defray the cost of such order.

SECTION 2. Chapter 56 of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is amended as follows:

56.30(4)(b)(3)(b) For a professional services contract with a value of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) or more, approval by the county board is required. Such approval may take place as part of the county board's adoption of the annual county budget. If approval does not take place as part of the adopted budget, then review by the appropriate county board standing committee and approval by the county board is immediate action required. If required to preserve preperty protect life, health and wolfare porcons, county board approval may waived, provided such shall be reported, in writing, forty eight (48) hours after action, to tho the county executivedepartment of administration.

SECTION 3. The provisions of these amended ordinances shall be effective upon passage publication.
