From the Executive Director of Parks requesting authorization to grant waivers to special event organizers for events that impede access to Lincoln Memorial Drive on various dates in 2022, by recommending adoption of the following:

AN AMENDED RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Section 47.031(5) of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances (the Code) requires any event sponsor who wishes to conduct an event that impedes access to Lincoln Memorial Drive (LMD) to petition the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors, through the Committee on Parks, Energy, and Environment (PE&E), for a waiver if their event does not conform to one or more conditions or restrictions listed in Sections 47.031 (1) through (4) of the Code; and

WHEREAS, five event organizers have applied to the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture (DPRC) for special event permits that would impede access to LMD on various dates in 2022; and

WHEREAS, these events have brought thousands of participants and visitors to Milwaukee, that increase exposure and contribute directly to our local economy; and

WHEREAS, event organizers are required to pay all fees required by DPRC for closing LMD, and permitting to host its event on park property; and

WHEREAS, event organizers must also apply for and receive permits from the City of Milwaukee; and

WHEREAS, discussions with lakefront stakeholders will occur, and every effort will be made to minimize business interruption along the routes; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, at its meeting on January 25, 2022, staff from the DPRC testified the United Performing Arts Fund Ride for the Arts wishes to change the date of the event from June 4th to June 5th; and

WHEREAS, access to lakefront venues will be coordinated with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on PE&E, at its meeting of January 25, 2022, recommended adoption of File No. 22-130 as amended (vote 4-0); now, therefore,
