11 12 13 14	WHEREAS, the Federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021 was signed into law by President Biden on March 11, 2021, in efforts to provide support to individuals, families, and businesses impacted by the Coronavirus Disease pandemic; and
15 16 17 18	WHEREAS, Milwaukee County (the County) will directly receive \$183.7 million in ARPA funding, through the Federal government's State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund; and
19 20 21 22 23	WHEREAS, on June 24, 2021, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) approved a resolution (Adopted File No. 21-555) to establish the ARPA Task Force, which will use a public process to make non-binding recommendations for ARPA allocations to the County Board; and
24 25 26 27 28	WHEREAS, of the County's \$183.7 million of ARPA aid, approximately \$115,728,599 has been allotted for Revenue Loss Recovery projects, which may include expenditures being considered by the Revenue Loss Recovery Subgroup, such as addressing the backlog of capital projects and deferred maintenance; and
29 30 31 32	WHEREAS, the County must embrace digital transformation to use the full capability of existing information systems, to avoid operational inefficiencies coupled with increased expenses; and
33 34 35 36 37	WHEREAS, ongoing budget challenges have required the Information Management Services Division (IMSD), Department of Administrative Services (DAS), to increasingly allocate funds to operational activities rather than delivering digital transformation projects; and
38 39 40 41	WHEREAS, a digital transformation roadmap for the County is necessary to identify projects to transform traditional manual processes to modern, automated, or digitized processes; and
42 43 44 45 46	WHEREAS, the County can benefit from a third party's perspective due to a third party's experience across other governmental organizations, knowledge of best practices, and ability to easily work across departments during an assessment; and

WHEREAS, IMSD-DAS requested \$500,000 of ARPA funds to establish a digital 47 transformation assessment project, and set aside of \$10 million to execute the 48 assessment's digital transformation roadmap, which will be procured via the County's 49 standard bid process; and 50 51 WHEREAS, the ARPA Task Force met on December 2, 2021, and 52 recommended approval of the requested \$500,000 for a digital transformation 53 assessment and set aside of \$10 million to execute the digital transformation roadmap, 54 with the requirement IMSD-DAS seek ARPA Task Force and County Board approval 55 prior to spending reserved funds; and 56 57 WHEREAS, at its meeting on January 27, 2022, Committee on Finance 58 members expressed a desire to better clarify the allocation of the funds, including 59 the opportunity to review the recommendations of the digital transformation 60 assessment plan before approving the allocation of funds from the \$10 million in 61 ARPA funding reserved to execute the plan; and 62 63 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance, at its meeting of January 27, 2022, 64 recommended adoption of File No. 22-106 as amended (vote 6-1); now, therefore, 65 66 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) 67 hereby authorizes the Office of Strategy, Budget, and Performance (OSBP), and the 68 Office of the Comptroller to create a new Capital Improvement Project, WY0726 -69 Milwaukee County Digital Transformation Initiative, and process provide an 70 administrative appropriation transfer in the amount of \$500,000 from Milwaukee 71 County's allocated American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding, to establish budget 72 authority for a new digital transformation assessment plan capital project; and 73 74 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the County Board hereby reserves and 75 earmarks an allocation of authorizes OSPB, and the Office of the Comptroller, to 76 process a \$10 million administrative appropriation transfer in ARPA funding to an 77 allocated contingency account in Capital Improvement Project WY0726 -78 Milwaukee County Digital Transformation Initiative the Information Management 79 Services Division (IMSD), Department of Administrative Services (DAS), for 80 execution of the digital transformation assessment plan project, subject to future 81 County Board approval, prior to spending reserved the funds held in the allocated 82 contingency account; and 83 84
