Unit 8000 - Department of Health and Human Services to allow the Children, Youth, and Family Services Division to enter into an agreement with the ONE Milwaukee Taskforce to dismantle the school to prison pipeline.
- B. Adoption of this resolution authorizes the transfer of \$100,000 from Org. Unit 1940-1945 Appropriation for Contingencies to Org. Unit 8000 - Department of Health and Human Services to allow the Children, Youth, and Family Services Division to enter into an agreement for \$100,000 with the ONE Milwaukee Taskforce to dismantle the school to prison pipeline.
- C. Adoption of this resolution has a budgetary impact of \$100,000. It authorizes the Department of Administrative Services to process an administrative transfer of \$100,000 from the 2022 Appropriation for Contingencies account. Org. Unit 1940-1945 Appropriation for Contingencies was allocated \$5,000,464 in the 2022 Budget. To the extent these funds are used will reduce the County's year-end surplus or increase its deficit.
