- A. Approval of this resolution will memorialize the human suffering caused by an individual who drove through a Christmas parade in the City of Waukesha on November 5, 2021. This resolution would further call on the Wisconsin Governor and Legislature to enact legislation moving away from a cash bail system based on a model implemented in the State of New Jersey. The New Jersey judicial system releases alleged criminals pre-trial based on a risk assessment of fleeing judicial proceedings and the level of potential hazard to public safety. State of New Jersey reports indicate trial appearance rates are comparable to the bail regime in their system and pretrial defendants who commit crimes are few.
- B. There are no direct costs associated with this resolution. Existing staff time would be needed to communicate the contents of the resolution to State policymakers. A New Jersey-style system in Wisconsin may require more funding for pretrial monitoring and speedy judicial proceedings but may reduce incarceration costs. However, this fiscal note does not attempt to calculate those costs as it ultimately requires legislative action from the State of Wisconsin.
- C. No budgetary impacts are expected in this or subsequent years. The resolution would not authorize the expenditure of any additional funds.
