The Department of Administrative Services Information Management Services Division (DAS-IMSD), working in conjunction with other staff as needed, is requested to develop administrative guidelines for a technical platform for an Open Data Portal that is supportable, updateable, and accessible. DAS-IMSD is requested to provide a report to the County Board of Supervisors for consideration no later than the September 2022 meeting cycle on the steps taken to expand the Open Data initiative and resources that may be needed to facilitate the effort.
- B. There are no additional direct costs related to this resolution. An expenditure of staff time will be required to develop the administrative guidelines and provide a report.
- C. This resolution does not have a budgetary impact in 2022 or subsequent years. Future expansion of the Open Data Portal, however, may result in additional costs or staff time that have not yet been identified.
