From the Director of Compensation/Human Resources Information Systems, Department of Human Resources, requesting an increase in constitutional office of Clerk of Circuit Court salary, in accordance with Milwaukee County Ordinance Section 17.98 for the next eligible term, by recommending adoption of the following:

A REVISED RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, in 2019, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) adopted an amendment to File No. 19-810, increasing compensation for the position of Comptroller, as a statutory elected official called for in Section 17.98 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances (the Code) by four percent; and

WHEREAS, in 2020, the County Board approved increasing the compensation for the positions of Register of Deeds, Treasurer, and County Clerk by four percent (File No. 20-257); and

WHEREAS, in 2022, the County Board approved increasing the compensation for the position of Sheriff by four percent (File No. 22-148); and

WHEREAS, Section 17.98 of the Code outlines the process by which Milwaukee County can adjust the salary of certain elected officials, in accordance with Wisconsin State Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Human Resources has reviewed the salary for the position of Clerk of Circuit Court, and is recommending the salary for the Clerk of Circuit Court to be increased by a consistent four percent, effective the first day of the new term, after the applicable general election; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Personnel, at its meeting of March 8, 2022, recommended adoption of File No. 22-416 (vote 5-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts a four percent salary increase for the position of Clerk of Circuit Court, effective the first day of the applicable new term, after the applicable 2022 general election:
