Due to the nature of the workforce that supports the contracted services we provide to the Fiserv Forum, County Zoo and Milwaukee Admirals, we are finding it difficult to fully staff these events and provide adequate patient services. By not fully staffing these events we are running into adequate levels of care issues with the number of providers. Safety is the number one concern and venue/patient safety is compromised when not adequately staffed.
- B. This position(s) will be funded from the revenue provided in the Office of Emergency Managements' contracted services, including Fiserv Forum, MC Zoo, UW-M Panthers, Wisconsin Center District, DSHA High School, Community/County CPR classes and Parks Lifeguard classes. This position will be hired near early May, pay period 9. The pay grade is at 23M and the prorated 2022 salary will be around \$41,207. Subsequently, assuming a full year service the salary will total \$59,522.
